NOTES

- (1) Within one month after he begins to occupy or use any premises as a factory the occupier must serve written notice of occupation on the Inspector and the Local Health Authority for the district. If he fails to do so he shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of one hundred dollars or five dollars for each day since the expiration of the month aforesaid, whichever is the greater.
- (2) Within one month of the date upon which mechanical power is first used in any factory, the occupier must serve on the Inspector and the Local Health Authority for the district a written notice stating the nature of such mechanical power.
